

VAL Summer Arts Festival 2024 – Rules

- **Registration Dates:**
 - **Priority Registration: 5/31/2024**
 - **General Registration: 6/7/2024 – 6/21/2024**
 - **Registration Closes: 6/21/2024** (In order to get the program printed with participants names.)
 - Submissions mailed prior to these dates will not be accepted. If spaces fill prior to 6/21/24 you will be notified and put on a waiting list.
- **Registration fee: \$25.00 NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER 6/26/2024.**
- The artist must be a member of the VAL in good standing. (Membership dues current and have attended at least 3 meetings.)
- Each artist must apply as an individual. Only 1 registration per envelope.
- Participants must be members for a minimum of 3 months prior to the show.
 - Only items listed on the registration form can be exhibited/sold. You must circle the medium(s) you will be exhibiting/selling. **NO CRAFTS ALLOWED**
 - Only one artist per table
 - New members that have not attended 3 meetings yet and wish to participate will be put on a waiting list.
 - Work must be the artist's own creation
 - VAL display cards are on the website for use to describe & price your art.
- Artist's spaces will be allotted according to USPO date stamp.
- This is a 2 dimensional and 3 dimensional show as described below:
- **2D artwork must be matted in clear cellophane envelopes and/or framed. Canvas paintings do not have to be framed.**
- **3D art is limited to art that is designed using raw materials that have been made into an art object.** (Examples: clay made into art objects, jewelry made from gem stones, wood that has been carved etc.) 3D pieces made from manufactured craft materials from stores and online craft sites such as plastic beads, shells etc. and ribbon or fabric are not allowed.
- **Friday Night Set Up** is from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM
- **Saturday Morning Set Up** is from 7:00 AM to 8:30 AM. You must be ready for the show at 8:30 AM.
- 9:00 AM- show opens to the public (Note: They will probably show up early)
- 3:00PM – **Show closes at 3:00 and artists are NOT ALLOWED TO BREAK DOWN PRIOR TO 3:00.** (Early breakdown may disqualify as artist from future shows.)
- Parking – after unloading, move your vehicle to the pool side of the building or further out in the parking lot to allow visitors and patrons closer parking.
- Each space is 12'x5' and can be set up with 2- 6' tables or 1 -6' table and a 6' open space or 12' open space. Each space can have 1 or 2 chairs. **Artists may not trade spaces with other artists. (Violation can result is expulsion.) You must stay within your allotted space and not encroach on another artist's space, exit, doorway,...**
- Tables must be covered to the floor and on all sides to conceal items under your table.
- Packing materials must be out of sight or taken to your vehicle. **AISLES AND DOORS CANNOT BE BLOCKED.**
- Tables cannot be moved – this is a liability issue.
- REMEMBER TO WEAR YOUR VAL MEMBERSHIP NAME TAG AND HAVE A WONDERFUL SHOW
